## PRESS RELEASE KETCHIKAN POLICE DEPARTMENT RELEASE DATE: NOVEMBER 22, 2019



On 11/06/19, the Ketchikan Police Department reported the arrest of Spencer D. Hill, age 22, for Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance –  $2^{nd}$  Degree, Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance –  $3^{rd}$  Degree and Misconduct Involving Weapons –  $3^{rd}$  Degree. This information can be referenced in that press release. The case investigation continued.

On 11/7/19, officers of the Ketchikan Police Department, in furtherance of this ongoing investigation into the importation and distribution of Heroin and Methamphetamine to Ketchikan by Mr. Hill, executed a search warrant on a safe deposit box belonging to Mr. Hill at a Ketchikan bank. Approximately 3.2 pounds of suspected Methamphetamine and 1.79 pounds of suspected Heroin were seized from the box. Additional criminal charges are pending in reference to this seizure and the investigation will continue. The potential street value of the narcotics combined, if broken down into user amounts for each drug at the going rate in Ketchikan, is over one million dollars.
