On September 8, 2021 Officers of the Ketchikan Police Department completed an investigation into the importation and distribution of Fentanyl into Ketchikan. Officers conducted a controlled delivery of a parcel containing 150 pills of alleged Fentanyl to Caleb C. Davis (24 YOA) at his residence, and a search warrant was executed where he was found to be in possession of the pills as well as evidence of drug use and sales.

Mr. Davis was placed under arrest for Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree for possession of Fentanyl with intent to distribute, Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree for possession of Fentanyl, and Violation of Conditions of Release. He was transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center where he was booked accordingly and held without bail.
