1. Rate Study

PowerPoint presentation was given by Harbor Operations Coordinator James Wilson. He noted that a 2.4 percent rate increase every year will combat inflation and if we can do this in two years, we will begin seeing changes in our budget and can start projects again. He also suggested a rate increase across the board. The last rate increase paid for the drive down ramp.

Discussion was held. Most Port & Harbors Advisory Board members agreed to a rate increase. With the exception of the 2.4 percent increase, that yearly addition should be based on an index or be in line with a City wide increase.

Harbor Operations Coordinator James Wilson reviewed the Director's Report.

He stated that the Berth III expansion project had stalled out due to lack of funding.

The Harbor office is switching its operating software to Dockwa. Wilson advised that better reporting would be available on Dockwa system.

Harbor Operations Coordinator James Wilson presented Bay Company's proposal requesting a reserve moorage stall to work on any boat with a work order. Board members opposed the request.
