PUBLIC NOTICE – 05/06/25

DOT&PF Wolfe Point Slope Stability Improvements

05/06 - 05/13/25 Secon and DOT&PF will be drilling and placing stabilization dowls into rock face. No traffic impediments are expected during construction, unless conditions change.

## Blasting Notice:

<u>There will be a blasting event on either Saturday 10<sup>th</sup>, or Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> May between 9am-3:30pm at Wolfe Point – 4418 Tongass Avenue between MP 3.0 & 3.2. Expect 15–20-minute delays in traffic during the blasting event. As we get closer to the weekend another notice will go out with set blast date.</u>

At the time of the blast, Flaggers will be stationed at the road closure point to ensure no unauthorized entry.

The following blast signals will be sounded on an air horn:

- Blast warning signal- A series of 5 (five) long signals, 5 minutes prior to blasting.
- Blasting imminent: A series of short signals 1 (one) minute prior to blast.
- All clear signal: One (1) long signal following the inspection of the blast area.

## Safety Reminder

- Speed limit is 20 mph
- No pedestrian access through the bypass during this time

Please follow all posted signs for speed limits, detours, and lane changes. Thank you for your patience!
