



PUBLIC NOTICE – 05/06/25

DOT&PF Wolfe Point Slope Stability Improvements

05/06 – 05/13/25 Secon and DOT&PF will be drilling and placing stabilization dowls into rock face. No traffic impediments are expected during construction, unless conditions change.

Blasting Notice:

There will be a blasting event on either Saturday 10<sup>th</sup>, or Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> May between 9am-3:30pm at Wolfe Point – 4418 Tongass Avenue between MP 3.0 & 3.2. Expect 15–20-minute delays in traffic during the blasting event. As we get closer to the weekend another notice will go out with set blast date.

At the time of the blast, Flaggers will be stationed at the road closure point to ensure no unauthorized entry.

The following blast signals will be sounded on an air horn:

- Blast warning signal- A series of 5 (five) long signals, 5 minutes prior to blasting.
- Blasting imminent: A series of short signals 1 (one) minute prior to blast.
- All clear signal: One (1) long signal following the inspection of the blast area.

Safety Reminder

- Speed limit is 20 mph
- No pedestrian access through the bypass during this time

Please follow all posted signs for speed limits, detours, and lane changes. Thank you for your patience!
