NEW BUSINESS:

1. Resolution in Support of an Application for Municipal Harbor Facility Grant Program Funding for the Replacement of Bar Harbor North Ramp 3.

Berg explained this is the exact application as last year, just updated with 2017 information.

MOTION: Flora moved to recommend to the City Council that they adopt Resolution No. 18-2703 Authorizing an application for municipal harbor facility grant program funding for the replacement of Bar Harbor North Ramp 3; agreeing to provide for local maintenance of such funded improvements as required; and establishing an effective date. Acting Director's Report:

- 1. **Highliner Wall Failure:** A sink hole was noticed Thursday, June 28th by Harbor Maintenance. The parking lot was cleared for safety reasons, and on the morning of Sunday, July 1st the sink hole became large enough to warrant removing ramp one. On the morning of Monday July 2, the seawall completely failed. Western Dock and Bridge has been on scene since the Sunday sink hole and is working to stabilize and rebuild the seawall and parking lot. The estimated date of completion is unknown.
- 2. Sourdough Tours: It was brought to the council's attention last week that Sourdough Tours was feeding eagles on their property between Bar Harbor South and The Point. It was determined it is not illegal, but that it could be considered littering. The direction was given by City Council to monitor the feeding and cite the owner if he is seen feeding the eagles. The issue will further be addressed at the July 19th City Council meeting.

3. **Port Charter Vessel Loading Zones:** This program has been going well, and the vast majority of Captains are becoming compliant.
